WEEKEND REVIEW

Dover Athletic's inexorable march towards the Premier Division title continued with a come-from-behind 2-1 victory at Ashford Town

LEAGUE NEWS

(Middlesex), whilst their nearest challengers, Staines Town and Tonbridge Angels drew – 0-0 at Dartford and 2-2 at home to Maidstone United, respectively. Surrey neighbours Sutton United and Carshalton Athletic are fourth and fifth after victories. The Us saw off Horsham 2-1 at Gander Green Lane and the Robins – the last unbeaten away team in the top three tiers of Non-League football – won 2-1 at Boreham Wood. At the foot of the table, Heybridge Swifts moved to within two points of Margate, with four games in hand, after they won 3-2 at Tooting & Mitcham United and the Gate slumped 3-0 at AFC Hornchurch. Ramsgate, who drew 2-2 with Wealdstone at Southwood Stadium, Harrow Borough, 3-1 conquerors of Billericay Town, and Hendon, 2-0 home winners against Canvey Island, all rose one place at the expense of Harlow Town, who fell into the bottom three after losing 3-2 at Hastings United.

There was a huge surprise in Division One North, where 21st-placed Waltham Forest beat leaders Aveyley 2-0 at Mill Field. That allowed the Stags, under new boss Olawale Ojelabi, to move out of the bottom two, while East Thurrock United regained top spot courtesy of their last-gasp 1-0 win at home to Chatham Town. A solitary goal was also enough for Brentwood Town to stay in third place, Thamesmead Town returning from Essex empty-handed. Ware jumped two places back into the top four as they won 1-0 at strugglers Witham Town and Waltham Abbey suffered a 4-0 reverse at Cheshunt, while Northwood

were held to a 1–1 draw at Chestnut Avenue by fellow promotion-chasers Wingate & Finchley. Hillingdon Borough's plight is beginning to look desperate as their 3–0 defeat at Enfield Town left them eight points away from safety and six behind Witham. Ilford did their survival hopes a power of good at Cricklefield Stadium with a 2–0 defeat of Leyton. Great Wakering Rovers were the fourth team in the Division to record a 1–0 victory, overcoming Redbridge at Burroughs Park. The other two matches, at Concord Rangers and Maldon Town, ended in 1–1 draws, Tilbury collecting a point at Thames Road, and Potters Bar Town likewise at Park Drive.

Kingstonian kept their three-point lead in Division One South after winning 2–0 at Leatherhead. Cray Wanderers were 3–1 winners against fellow promotion hopefuls Dulwich Hamlet at Hayes Lane to go second, while Ashford Town, now third, went one better, putting four past Burgess Hill Town. Metropolitan Police slipped two places as their match at Corinthian–Casuals was postponed. The top five is completed by Worthing, whose 1–1 home draw against Fleet Town was matched by sixth-placed Sittingbourne, held by Croydon Athletic at the Bourne Stadium. Crowborough Athletic are eight points adrift from a group of three teams in the bottom four after losing 1–0 at another of those teams, Walton Casuals. Whitstable Town lost by the same score at Folkestone Invicta. Merstham and Kevin Lock earn special mention, the former for the being the League's highest scorers on Saturday, with five against Walton & Hersham, who failed to reply, and the latter for scoring four times, the only hat-trick or better of the weekend. Eastbourne Town saw off Godalming Town 2–1 at The Saffrons and Chipstead also won 2–1, at Whyteleafe.

Premier Division

A match between two teams without a League draw between them seemed unlikely to end all square, but leaders Dover Athletic might have settled for that when Scott Harris gave Ashford Town (Middlesex) the lead after 29 minutes at Short Lane. Jerahl Hughes finally netted an equaliser after 69 minutes, but Lee Browning netted Dover's winner five minutes later. Staines Town dropped a further two points behind as they played out a goalless draw at Dartford. Although the Swans have five games in hand, they are 25 points behind the runaway leaders.

Tonbridge Angels threw away a two-goal lead in the last ten minutes at home to Maidstone

United. John Westcott, five minutes, and Carl Rook, 30, had put the Angels in the driving seat, but Jay Saunders pulled a goal back for the Stones with ten minutes to go and Peter Hawkins equalised right at the death. At Imperial Fields, all five goals came in 27 second-half minutes. Tooting & Mitcham United took the lead with a Paul Vines penalty after 51 minutes, only for Danny Rochester to equalise for visiting Heybridge Swifts four minutes later. Perry Sansfuro then scored twice in three minutes for the Division's basement-dwellers, after 73 and 76 minutes, only for Joe Vines to set up a grandstand finale with Tooting's second 12 minutes from time.

Margate have lost three games more than any team in the Division, their 16th coming in a 3–0 reverse at AFC Hornchurch, were Ross Wall scored after three and 61 minutes and Kris Lee got the other after 75 minutes. Harlow Town are now in the bottom three, albeit with games in hand over the five teams above them, after losing 3–2 at Hastings United. Sam Adams gave Hastings the lead after 41 minutes, and Frankie Sawyer and Matt MacLain extended the advantage after 76 and 79 minutes. The Hawks fought back with goals from Raphael Sylvester after 81 minutes and Luke Webster, 90, but it was too little, too late. Hendon climbed to 19th in the table after a goal in each half was enough to see off Canvey Island at Wheatsheaf Park, Staines. Harry Hunt struck after 34 minutes and a Ryan Oliva own goal after 77 minutes completed the 2–0 victory.

Harrow Borough made it one defeat in the last seven with a 3–1 victory at home to Billericay Town, despite trailing to an own goal from Wayne Walters after 19 minutes. Jonathan Constant levelled matters nine minutes before the break, before Lee Hall, 65 minutes, and Wayne Clarke, 76, sealed the points. Ramsgate shared the spoils with Wealdstone, drawing 2–2 at home. Ben Brown gave the Rams the lead after four minutes, but Davis Haule struck twice for the Stones, after 30 and 38 minutes, to give them a half-time lead. Ryan Royston rescued a point for the Rams after 76 minutes.

Sutton United debutant Jon Munday made a great start with a goal against Horsham after 15 minutes. Russell Eldridge equalised for the Hornets after 36 minutes, but Billy Dunn sent the Gander Green Lane faithful home happy with the winner after 62 minutes. Boreham Wood's slide continues as a pair of Richard Jolly goals, after 57 and 60 minutes, gave

Carshalton Athletic all three points at Meadow Park. Wood, who have lost eight of their last 11, had led through Chris Watters' goal after 35 minutes.

Division One North

Goals from Gary Richford, 58 minutes, and Joel Palmer, 72, were enough for struggling Waltham Forest to pull off the shock of the day, a 2–0 victory at erstwhile leaders Aveley. East Thurrock United have taken over at the head of affairs after Ben Wood struck three minutes into stoppage time to give the Rocks a 1–0 victory over Chatham Town at Rookery Hill. Three other matches in the Division were settled by a solitary goal: Mitch Hahn's 44th-minute strike kept Brentwood Town third after their home win against Thamesmead Town; Ware jumped back to fourth courtesy of Daryl Wilson's goal after 24 minutes at Witham Town; and Billy Johnson was Great Wakering Rovers' match-winner after 71 minutes at home against Redbridge.

Ilford did their survival hopes a power of good with a 2–0 home win over Leyton. Tony Russell scored in the first minute and Chris Taylor got the other after 74 minutes. At Theobalds Lane, Cheshunt hit four without reply against Waltham Abbey, who nonetheless remain in the last of the playoff places. Michael Pelley, seven minutes, and Ola Akkinawo, 19, made it 2–0 at half-time, and Ashley Taylor-Forbes and Mervin Abraham completed the scoring after 70 and 76 minutes. At the Goldsdown Ground, Enfield Town added to Hillingdon Borough's troubles with a 3–0 victory. An own goal from Ashley Fongho gave the Towners a first-half lead and two more goals, in five minutes just after half-time, from Michael Deane and Danny Wolf, completed the scoring.

The other three matches ended in 1–1 draws. Northwood slipped out of the playoff places after being held at home by Wingate & Finchley, for whom Marvin Samuel scored after 28 minutes. Brad Hewitt saved a point for the Woods with the leveller midway through the second half. Nicky Cowley gave Concord Rangers the lead after 23 minutes against Tilbury at Thames Road, but Gary Burrell restored parity after 72 minutes. Nicky Love scored after 15 minutes of his Maldon Town debut at home to Potters Bar Town, but Sam Adejokun earned the Scholars a point with his 70th-minute equaliser.

Division One South

An own goal by Leatherhead's Jason Henry was the breakthrough Kingstonian needed at Fetcham Grove. His own goal after 58 minutes

was added to by Simon Huckle three minutes later as the Ks ran out 2–0 winners to stay three points clear at the top of the table – and they have three games in hand. Cray Wanderers raced to a 3–0 half-time lead at home to Dulwich Hamlet, with goals from Steve Aris, four minutes, Dean Standen, 26, and Mark Willy, 34. Marc Cumberbatch pulled a goal back from the penalty spot with 11 minutes to go, but it was little more than a consolation for the Hamlet. At the Homelands, Ashford Town scored twice in each half as they beat Burgess Hill Town 4–1. Craig Wilkins, after 14 and 54 minutes, Paul Jones, 40, and Bradley Spice, 86, were their scorers, while Steve Harper was the Hillians' marksman, netting an equaliser after 37 minutes. The Nuts & Bolts have now won seven in a row.

Merstham's Kevin Lock produced the individual performance of the day, scoring after 44, 34, 70 and 89 minutes in his team's 5–0 demolition of Walton & Hersham. Michael Morgan got the other goal, after 80 minutes. Colin Richmond gave Sittingbourne the lead four minutes before half time against Croydon Athletic, but an own goal from Matt Reed levelled the scores, and the teams had to settle for a point each. It also ended 1–1 at Nyewood Lane, Bognor Regis, where James Field gave visiting Fleet Town a 40th-minute lead. Ross Treleaven saved a point for Worthing with the equaliser 11 minutes into the second half.

Crowborough Athletic's losing run is now at ten League matches, the latest being a 1–0 reverse at fellow strugglers Walton Casuals. Yet another player scored on his debut, Paul Armstrong, netting after 64 minutes for his new team. A solitary goal, from Jimmy Jackson after 67 minutes, was enough for Folkestone Invicta to claim the spoils against visiting Whitstable Town.

The other two games to be played – Corinthian–Casuals' game at home to Metropolitan Police was postponed – ended in 2–1 scorelines. At The Saffrons, Ethan Strevett gave Eastbourne Town the lead in the second minute against Godalming Town. Graeme Purdey did equalise after 27 minutes, but Liam Baitup netted the winner 20 minutes from time. At Church Road, Andrew Martin gave hosts Whyteleafe the lead after 22 minutes, but Gavin Quintayne restored parity for Chipstead from the penalty spot seven minutes later. It was the 100th goal – for and against – in Chipstead's 24 League fixtures

this season. The Chips' winner came in the final minute from Josh Smith.

Ryman Youth League

The Ryman Youth League finally returned to action this week for the first time in January, with six League matches and three Cup matches successfully concluded.

North West Division leaders Staines Town extended their lead at the top of the table to ten points with a 3-2 win at Corinthian-Casuals, whilst Kingstonian remain in third spot behind AFC Wimbledon following their 202 home draw with Tooting & Mitcham United.

Also sharing the spoils with a 1-1 draw were Walton & Hersham and Hampton & Richmond Borough Football Clubs, leaving Carshalton Athletic as the week's top winners, 7-1 at Godalming Town, with Stephen Newman and Paul Nichols notching two apiece.

In the South East Division, 2nd and 3rd placed Croydon Athletic and Maidstone United shared four goals and the points on Wednesday evening. However, they both dropped a place as fourth placed Lewes moved up to second spot with a strong 4-1 win at home the Divisional leaders Eastbourne Town – Ryan Storrie and Fred Foreman hitting two each, with a lone reply from Scott Dartnell for the visitors.

Is the Isthmian Youth Cup on Thursday evening, holders Leatherhead beat hosts Horsham 2-1 in the last of the First Round matches, whilst in a Second Round match, Burgess Hill Town and Worthing drew 2-2 before floodlight planning permission forced the match to be halted without extra time being possible.

Also in the Second Round, AFC Wimbledon won 3-2 against Woking in a game that was a credit to both sets of players, both clubs. and a credit the to Ryman Youth League and youth football. AFC Wimbledon were three goals clear with just over half an hour played through goals from Ollie Killick (two) and Billy Manning, and although Woking scored through Smith and Ausan Cousins, it was not quite enough to save the match.

JIM THOMPSON

Former Chairman and President of the Football Conference, and a former Maidstone United chairman, Jim Thompson has died at the age of 75. Mr Thompson, from Otham, died at the Heart of Kent Hospice, Aylesford,

on Friday morning. He had been suffering from cancer.

Mr Thompson, who was a former managing director of the Kent Messenger Group, leaves a wife, Katie, and a son, Rod, and daughter, Fiona.

Former KM editor Peter Edwards said: "Jim was my managing director when I was KM Editor in the 1970s. He was a very talented advertising guru who, deep down, I felt, had always wished he had been a journalist. He was quick of mind, decisive in everything he did but did not suffer fools gladly.

"Under a tough, uncompromising exterior, there was a soft centre and I always found Jim to be a most kind and generous man with a well developed sense of humour and an ability to make friends quickly.

"His work with non-league clubs in getting the Football League to accept the pyramid system of football promotion and relegation deserved more recognition than it received."

WALTHAM FOREST FC

Waltham Forest Football Club have admitted that in the Isthmian League Cup Second Round match against Witham Town on 25th November, they played an ineligible player. The result of the match was a 5-0 win for Waltham Forest.

Waltham Forest F.C. have been removed from the competition and Witham Town reinstated. Witham Town will now play away at AFC Hornchurch on Tuesday, 20th January in the Third Round of the Isthmian League Cup.
