LEAGUE NEWS

It has been a difficult season for Heybridge Swifts Football Club, currently at the foot of the Premier Division. Faced with a difficult match at Tooting & Mitcham United on 17th January, the Essex side recorded only their fourth win of the season to beat their hosts 3-2, and win themselves the Premier Division Team Performance award for January.

On the same Saturday afternoon as Heybridge went to Tooting, Waltham Forest, in 21st position in Division One North, travelled to visit leaders Aveley, with just one win to their credit since the middle of October, under the guidance of a new manager. They went on to record a 2-0 victory to win Waltham Forest the Team Performance award for Division One North for the month of January.

Merstham, champions of the Combined Counties League last season, have made a good start to their first season in the Ryman Football League Division One South, and currently sit just outside the play-off places. On Saturday, 17th January, they achieved their best win of an impressive season with a 5-0 home victory against the well established Walton & Hersham Football Club. As a result, Merstham have won the Team Performance award for Division One South for January.

WEEKEND REVIEW

Friday night's game saw Staines Town cut Dover Athletic's Premier Division lead to 22 points (with four games in hand) after they saw off Hendon 2-0 at Vale Farm, Wembley FC. The Greens remain in trouble in the bottom four.

Saturday's fixtures saw two big shocks in the Premier Division. Both Dover Athletic and Ashford Town (Middlesex) drew matches, Dover 0-0 at Ramsgate, the Ash-Trees 1-1 at home to Carshalton Athletic. For both teams it was their first League encounters to end up all square. The point at Prices Avenue was enough to stretch Dover's lead to 23 points over Staines and Tonbridge Angels who overcame Margate with a solitary goal. Four other games also ended in 1-0 home wins, AFC Hornchurch, Boreham Wood, Dartford and Sutton United defeating, Canvey Island, Heybridge Swifts, Maidstone United and Billericay Town respectively. Harlow Town moved out of the bottom four at the expense of Harrow Borough, whom they beat 4-1 at Earlsmead. At Imperial Fields, a last-minute goal gave Wealdstone all three points in a 3-2 victory against Tooting & Mitcham United. In the other match, Horsham won 2-0 at Hastings United.

Aveley stay top of Division One North after holding off Potters Bar Town 3-2 at Mill Field. East Thurrock United stay second and did their goal-difference a power of good by crushing Ware 7-0, while Brentwood Town needed only one goal at home to Waltham Forest to take all three points. The bottom two met at Witham Town and Hillingdon Borough will be the happier team after a 1-1 draw. Ilford moved further away from the bottom three with a 1-0 defeat of Tilbury at Cricklefield Stadium. Northwood's long unbeaten League run continued with a 2-0 home win against Thamesmead Town and they moved back into the top five, just behind Waltham Abbey, 3-2 winners at Concord Rangers. Wingate & Finchley, however, lost ground on the top half-dozen as they went down 2-0 at nine-man Enfield Town. Redbridge won 2-1 at

Cheshunt and Chatham Town won 3-2 at Maldon Town. The most exciting game came at Burroughs Park, where hosts Great Wakering Rovers led twice in the second half against Leyton but had to settle for a point after a 3-3 draw.

The top two in Division Two South both lost on Saturday, leaders Kingstonian going down 4-1 at Worthing and Metropolitan Police losing 2-1 at fellow promotion candidates Ashford Town. Fleet Town are now second after they won 2-1 at Eastbourne Town, but although they are only two points behind Kingstonian, the Ks have played three games less than the four teams immediately behind them. The biggest winners in the Division were Corinthian-Casuals, who beat basement-dwellers Crowborough Athletic 5-1. The Crows are 11 points adrift of those above them, but Whitstable Town climbed out of the bottom two with by beating Leatherhead 2-1, and they joined the Tanners on 26 points. Walton Casuals remain in trouble after a 2-0 home defeat at the hands of Croydon Athletic, while there were two more 2-1 wins, for Godalming Town at Folkestone Invicta and Whyteleafe at home to Dulwich Hamlet. Sittingbourne left it late to score the opening goal at home to Walton & Hersham but it was enough to give them all three points. And Merstham and Burgess Hill Town shared the spoils after a 1-1 draw at Moatside.

Sunday's game between Cray Wanderers and Chipstead fell foul of the Saturday night frost and was called off.

Premier Division

Two goals in two minutes, from Howard Newton, 53 minutes, and Richard Butler, 55, were enough for Staines to take maximum points from their visit to Hendon. They have won both games between the sides by 2-0 this season after losing three times to the Greens in 2007-08.

A goalless draw at Ramsgate was enough for Dover Athletic to go 23 points clear of Staines Town and 24 ahead of Tonbridge Angels. The Angels collected maximum points with a Jamie Cade goal midway through the second half of their game at home to Margate, who remain in the bottom two. At the foot of the table, Heybridge Swifts slumped to a 1-0 defeat at Boreham Wood as Lee Allinson scored in the last minute.

There was also late drama at Tooting & Mitcham United, where the home team led

twice against Wealdstone, but lost 3–2. Paul Vines gave the Terrors and 18th-minute lead. Kieron Forbes equalised in the 43rd minute, but Michael Antonio netted Tooting's second moments before the interval. Ryan Ashe levelled matters midway through the second half before Danny Spendlove grabbed the last-gasp winner. AFC Hornchurch scored after just five minutes against Canvey Island, Dean Green the marksman, and they held on for the next 85 minutes. Sutton United did likewise for 60 minutes following Lynvall Duncan's 30th-minute strike against Billericay Town.

The biggest winners of the day were Harlow Town, who scored three times in the opening 26 minutes at Harrow Borough, Jamie Richards, John Frendo and Mark Taylor, a penalty, scoring. Borough pulled a goal back through Jonathan Constant after half an hour, but Frendo got his second ten minutes into the second half and it ended 4–1 to the Hawks. Also winning away from home was Horsham, who got goals from Lee Carney, 17 minutes, and Claude Seania, 90, to win 2–0 at Hastings United. The points were shared at Short Lane as Byron Harrison's tenth-minute opener for Ashford Town (Middlesex) was cancelled out by Richard Jolly's goal for Carshalton Athletic, five minutes before half-time. The other match, at Princes Park, was decided by Dartford's Rob Haworth. His goal after 63 minutes was enough to beat Maidstone United.

Division One North

Leaders Aveley twice trailed at home to Potters Bar Town, but prevailed 3–2. Sam Adejokun gave the Scholars the lead after five minutes, but Neil Richmond equalised after 20 minutes. Jonathan Spencer restored Potters Bar's lead five minutes before half-time. Four minutes after the restart, Joel Barnett restored parity and Richmond bagged his second with 13 minutes to go to win the game. There was little drama at Rookery Hill, where second-placed East Thurrock United ran riot against Ware, hitting seven without reply. Martin Tuohy led the way with four goals, after 15, 43, 61 and 88 minutes, Kurt Smith struck after 35 and 46 minutes, and Kris Newby converted a penalty eight minutes after the resumption.

Enfield Town had two players sent off in the first 55 minutes at home to Wingate & Finchley, then scored through Ryan Edgar and Rudi Hall to record a most unlikely 2–0 victory. There was goalscoring drama at Burroughs Park where Leyton visited Great Wakering Rovers. Michael Bakare's opener for Leyton

after 22 minutes was cancelled out 11 minutes later by Louis Sparrow. The teams turned around all square, but Rovers took the lead ten minutes after the resumption with a goal from Mark Cartlidge. Leyton hit back through Robert Carter ten minutes later, but fell behind again 11 minutes from time when Joel Etienne-Clark netted. But, with seven minutes to go Phil Kane made it 3–3. Chris Thomas scored the only goal after 23 minutes as Ilford picked up three vital points against Tilbury. And it was a solitary goal from Sherwin Stanley, after 82 minutes, that brought Brentwood Town victory at home to Waltham Forest.

Maldon Town twice equalised at home to Chatham Town, but eventually went down 3–2. In the first half, Lee Barnett and Rob Dennis scored either side of Nicky Love's goal for Maldon. After the break, Jerome Ingram equalised again, but Steve Best got the winner with 15 minutes to go. It was the same story at Thames Avenue, where Concord Rangers went down 3–2 against Waltham Abbey, the only difference being there were four goal in the first half. James Elmes scored twice for the Abbots, only for Danny Heale and Nicky Cowley to tie things up. The winner came from Lee Sontag 11 minutes from full time.

Anthony Page scored after seven minutes and Hugo Figueiredo after 90 as Northwood overcame Thamesmead Town 2–0 at Chestnut Avenue. It ended up all-square in the battle of the bottom two at Spa Road. Sean Madiga gave visitors Hillingdon Borough the lead after 15 minutes, but Dave Bearfield rescued a point for Witham Town after 69 minutes. All the scoring at Theobalds Lane came in the first half. Carl Bruce gave Redbridge the lead after three minutes, but Cheshunt were level within five minutes, courtesy of Gavin Taylor. Redbridge's winner came from Hakeem Araba's spot-kick eight minutes before oranges.

Division One South

Leaders Kingstonian fell behind after only six minutes of their trip to the A2B Stadium, Karl Akehurst giving Worthing the lead. Phil Williams equalised four minutes later, but that was as good as it got for the Ks, who conceded again to Ben Andrews after 16 minutes and Paul Kennett, 29. Ricky Demetriou rounded off a good afternoon for the Rebels, scoring the fourth after 80 minutes. Corinthian-Casuals went one better at home to hapless Crowborough Athletic, winning 5–1.

Joe Funicello opened the scoring on the stroke of half-time and Tyrone Myton made it 2–0 six minutes after the restart. Although Sam Carrington pulled a goal back three minutes later, Sam Robinson, Matt Powell and Jamie Reive struck after 61, 70 and 72 minutes, respectively to seal the victory.

At the Homelands, Ashford Town climbed above Metropolitan Police after beating them 2–1. Craig Wilkins, 55 minutes, and Paul Jones, 66, gave Ashford an advantage which became more precarious after Steve Sargent converted a penalty with 11 minutes to go, but they held on for the points. Fleet Town moved into second place after a 2–1 victory at Eastbourne Town. Nathan Smart scored both goals, the first after 52 minutes, the second with just three minutes to go. Eastbourne had equalised with 13 minutes to go, Luke Denton scoring.

James Dryden struck in the first minute for Folkestone Invicta at home to Godalming Town. But Glen Stanley equalised after 74 minutes and Andy Ottley was Godalming's match-winner, netting in the 87th minute. Leatherhead also took an early lead but lost 2–1 at home. Tom Hutchings converted a penalty after five minutes, but Ian Pulman equalised for Whitstable Town just before the half-hour mark. The Oystermen's winner came from Tom Parker early in the second half. Lloyd Cotton rescued a point for Burgess Hill Town with a 90th minute equaliser at Moatside. Merstham had taken the lead through Matt Francis after 20 minutes. At the Bourne ground, Sittingbourne relied Colin Richmond's 81st-minute strike to claim maximum points against Walton & Hersham.

Croydon Athletic won 2–0 at Walton Casuals, Jeremiah Olusanya opening the scoring after 39 minutes and Shabazz Baidoo made sure of the points with his goal eight minutes from the end. Whyteleaf took the lead at home to Dulwich Hamlet when Callum MacLean scored after 14 minutes. Three minutes into the second half Walid Matata equalised, but, almost immediately, Richard Dimmock scored what proved to be the Leaf's winner.

Sunday's match between Cray Wanderers and Chipstead at Hayes Lane was postponed due to a frozen pitch.

Ryman Youth League

Just three matches played in another wet weather dominated week. In the South East Division, second and third placed teams Eastbourne Town and Lewes both could have gone top with a win, but at the end of 90 minutes neither had succeeded, leaving Croydon Athletic Youths retaining top spot.

Burgess Hill Town beat Lewes by the only goal of the game on Tuesday evening, the same night Eastbourne Town were held to a 1-1 draw at home to Worthing.

In the Second Round of the Isthmian Youth Cup, Leyton went through to the next round with a 4-2 home won against Waltham Abbey.
