LEAGUE NEWS

DOVER ATHLETIC ARE PREMIER DIVISION CHAMPIONS

Congratulations are extended to Dover Athletic Football Club, who on Saturday afternoon became the Ryman Football League's Premier Division champions for season 2008/09. Shaun Welford scored two goals, with James Rogers, Frannie Collin, Matt Bodkin and Dean Hill also netting - as Dover clinched the title in style with their biggest win of the season - a 6-0 victory over Sutton United.

The League Championship Trophy and Shield will be presented to the Club at their next home match on Saturday, 11th April against Boreham Wood.

WEEKEND REVIEW

Congratulations are in order for Dover Athletic who, before March was out, clinched the Premier Division title. They did it in style, crushing fourth-placed Sutton United 6-0 at the Perrys Crabble. The other teams in the playoff places couldn't muster a victory as both second-placed Staines Town and Tonbridge Angels, in third, drew. Staines drew 1-1 at Hastings United, while Tonbridge shared four goals at Dartford. Carshalton Athletic went down 3-0 at home to Maidstone United, but stay fifth. Wealdstone's 1-0 defeat of Horsham saw them move into sixth place, albeit temporarily as AFC Hornchurch's Sunday afternoon 2-1 victory at Hendon restored the Urchins to sixth. At the bottom of the table Heybridge Swifts have joined

Ramsgate on 31 points after they won 1–0 at Harlow Town and the Rams slumped to a 3–0 defeat at Tooting & Mitcham United. Margate still have hopes of avoiding the drop after their 3–1 home victory against Billericay Town. Both Harrow Borough - 0–0 at Ashford Town (Middlesex), and Hastings moved a point clear of Harlow, who occupy the last relegation spot, behind Hendon only on goal difference. Boreham Wood remain in trouble after their 1–0 home defeat against Canvey Island.

By a strange quirk of the fixture computer, the top two in Division One North visited the bottom two and the formbook held up in both cases, though the scorelines could hardly have been more different. Leaders Aveley scored a solitary goal to see off basement-dwellers Hillingdon Borough, while East Thurrock United crushed Witham Town 10–2. It ended all square at 1–1 in the match between third and fifth at Brentwood Town, Northwood, now sitting two points clear of Concord Rangers, who also drew, 2–2 at home to Ilford. Waltham Abbey went down 2–0 at Tilbury but remain fourth. Hillingdon are relegated, sitting 12 points behind Witham and 20 away from Waltham Forest, who lost 1–0 at home to Cheshunt, with Ilford a point ahead of them. Wingate & Finchley failed to take advantage of the slips above them, going down 2–1 at Maldon Town. Enfield Town beat Potters Bar Town 3–1, while Chatham Town won 2–1 at Leyton. There were 1–0 victories for both Redbridge, at home to Thamesmead, and Great Wakering Rovers, at Ware.

First travelled to second in Division One South and it ended all-square. Hosts Fleet Town scored in the last minute to make it 1–1 against Cray Wanderers. Kingstonian remain third, despite being held to a 1–1 home draw by Whitstable Town, and it allowed Worthing and Metropolitan Police to close the gap with wins, Worthing overcoming Walton Casuals 2–1 at the A2B Stadium, and the Blues smashing Eastbourne United 5–2. They weren't the biggest scorers in the division, however, as Folkestone Invicta put eight past relegated Crowborough Athletic, though the Crows did hit two themselves. Sittingbourne are the only team likely to give the top five a run for their money as they are four points off a playoff place, but five clear of the chasing pack. They, too, were held to a 1–1 draw, in their case by Burgess Hill Town, who are in the relegation zone. Corinthian-Casuals moved out of the bottom three by beating Chipstead 2–1 at home, putting the two points clear of their opponents. There were no goals at Croydon Athletic, where Dulwich Hamlet were

the visitors and a single goal was enough for Merstham to take all three points at home to Leatherhead. Walton & Hersham drew 2–2 at home to Ashford Town, while Godalming Town snatched a 3–2 victory at Whyteleafe.

Premier Division

Dover Athletic claimed the Premier Division championship in style at the Perrys Crabble, hitting Sutton United for six. James Rogers scored before half-time, then Frannie Collin, Shaun Welford, twice, Matt Bodkin and Dean Hill all scored within 34 second half minutes. Staines Town led at Hastings United, courtesy of Elliot Onochie, but Sam Adams rescued a point in the final five minutes, converting a penalty. Tonbridge Angels led twice at Dartford, but had to settle for a point. Scott Gooding scored after three minutes, only for Bradley Woods-Garner to equalise 11 minutes later. Paul Booth made it 2–1 after 18 minutes, but Adam Flanagan levelled things again early in the second half.

Meshach Nugent and Ryan Royston scored in the first half for Maidstone United at Carshalton Athletic and Lloyd Blackman completed a miserable afternoon for the Robins with the Stones' third 15 minutes from the final whistle. A Ryan Ashe goal after 23 minutes brought them all three points against Horsham, while Ben Codling netted after 12 minutes to give Heybridge Swifts a similar result at fellow strugglers Harlow Town. A third 1–0 win was achieved at Boreham Wood, Leon Antoine scoring after 81 minutes for visitors Canvey Island. And there were no goals at all at Short Lane, where Ashford Town (Middlesex) and Harrow Borough took a point each.

Billericay Town took the lead at Margate with an 11th-minute goal from Paul Shave. But an own goal from Michael Alaile after 14 minutes restored parity, before Curtis Robinson, 25 minutes, and a Wayne Wilson penalty in the second half, gave the Gate a 3–1 victory. Ramsgate slipped to a 3–0 defeat at Tooting & Mitcham United, all the goals coming in the first half, from Dean McDonald, Billy Marshall and Paul Vines.

In the game on Sunday afternoon at Vale Farm, AFC Hornchurch leap-frogged over Wealdstone back into sixth place with a 2–1 victory over Hendon. Simon Parker, after ten minutes, and a 50th-minute own goal from James Parker set them on their way. Brian Haule reduced the arrears after 65 minutes, but the Greens couldn't find an equaliser.

Division One North

The plaudits must go to second-placed East Thurrock United, who struck ten past Witham Town. There were doubles for Martin Tuohy, Kris Newby and Ray Powell. The other four scorers were Brendon Cass, Kurt Smith, Lee Williams and Ben Boyce. Witham's two goals came from James Robinson and Gary Hill. Leaders Aveley ensured Hillingdon Borough's relegation with a Petrit Elbi goal after 56 minutes. Third-placed Brentwood Town equalised in the last minute at home to fifth-placed Northwood. Both goals came from the penalty spot, Lee Burrell scoring after an hour for Northwood, Danny Glozier rescuing a point for Brentwood.

Waltham Abbey conceded two goals at Tilbury, scored by Nathan Phillips after 32 minutes and Greg Cohen, 72, and couldn't get one in reply. Concord Rangers also failed to win, being held to a 2–2 home draw by lowly Ilford. Danny Heale gave Concord the lead after 14 minutes, only for Anton Trice to make it 1–1 a minute later. Anthony Cook thought his 58th-minute goal would be enough for Concord, but Victor Omagbehin snatched a point for the Foxes in the final minute. Wingate & Finchley also slipped up, 2–1 at Maldon Town. Nathan Fletcher gave the hosts the lead in the fourth minute, but Chris Chase equalised 12 minutes into the second half. Maldon's winner came in the last minute, courtesy of Niki Love.

Hakeem Araba scored the only goal after 74 minutes and it was enough for Redbridge to take all three points at home to Thamesmead Town, while Danny O'Connor did likewise after 52 minutes to give Cheshunt victory at Waltham Forest and Freskin Rusthiti was a third solitary goal match-winner, his third-minute strike for Great Wakering Rovers standing up at Ware.

Otis Williams scored after 15 minutes for Potters Bar Town at Enfield Town, but Ryan Edgar equalised after an hour and Ellis Remy struck twice for the Towners, after 68 and 90 minutes, to seal a 3–1 victory. In the other match, at Lea Bridge Road, Chatham Town's Lee Barnett scored after 61 and 77 minutes, while Leyton's only response was a last-minute goal from Phil Kane.

Division One South

Leaders Cray Wanderers were denied victory at second-placed Fleet Town when Darren Wheeler netted a last-minute equaliser. A Steve Noakes own goal after 41 minutes had given the Wands the lead. Kingstonian also

were denied victory by a late equalizer, Bobby Traynor's 38th-minute opener being cancelled out by Whitstable Town's Mark Munday, three minutes from the final whistle. At the A2B Stadium, Worthing, there also was a 90th-minute goal, but it brought the Rebels all three points against Walton Casuals. The visitors had taken the lead after 47 minutes, through Anthony Gale, but Ross Treleaven restored parity three minutes later. The last-minute goal hero was Worthing's Jamie Brotherton.

Crowborough Athletic endured a miserable afternoon at home to Folkestone Invicta, scoring twice, through Nathan Millroy and Dan Dunford, but they conceded, including a hat-trick for Jacob Arnold-Smith. Josh Vincent weighed in with two more and James Dryden, Frankie Chappell and Jimmy Jackson were also on the scoresheet. At the other end of the scale, at Croydon Athletic, where Dulwich Hamlet were the visitors, there were no goals. And one goal, from Kwabena Agyei of Merstham, after 37 minutes, was enough for the Moatmen to beat Leatherhead 1–0.

Metropolitan Police remain in the top five after a 5–2 win at Eastbourne Town. Jamie Byatt, 41 minutes, Scott Forrester, 43, Brad Drewett, 61 and 87, and Vernon Francis, 88, were their scorers. Reggie Salvidge got both for Eastbourne, after 44 and 81 minutes. Corinthian–Casuals did their survival hopes a power of good, defeating fellow strugglers Chipstead 2–1 at home. Gavin Cartwright and Saheed Sankoh scored after 22 and 31 minutes, respectively, while Gavin Quintyne converted a spot-kick for Chipstead early in the second half. Godalming Town won at Whyteleafe by the odd goal in five, despite being pegged back twice. Andy Ottley, after 14 minutes, and Glen Stanley, 54, saw their strikes cancelled out by Nigel Ikolodo, 25 minutes, and Andrew Martin, 65, but Graham Purdy netted the winner with 20 minutes to go.

The other two matches ended in draws. At Sittingbourne, Colin Richmond gave the hosts the lead after 21 minutes, but Burgess Hill Town got a point courtesy of Wes Tate's goal after 61 minutes. Craig Wilkins, 22 minutes, and Mitchell Sherwood, 52, gave Ashford Town two leads at Walton & Hersham, but substitute Julian Owusu-Bekoe struck back for the Swans, scoring after 59 and 72 minutes.

Ryman Youth League

Second placed AFC Wimbledon closed the gap at the top of the North West Division of the Ryman Youth League by three points behind leaders Staines Town, but also lost ground as

they lost their first Youth League match of the season as well. On Monday evening the Young Dons lost 2-3 at Woking, Rob Carr scoring the winning goal in injury time at the end of the second half. Then on Thursday evening, the Young Dons won 3-1 at Kingstonian, Peter Rapson hitting a hat-trick for the second time this season.

Elsewhere in the North West Division, Walton & Hersham beat Godalming Town 5-2, with a hat-trick here coming from Tariq Sidaoui.

In the South East Division, there was no change at the head of the table as the top two, having dropped points last week, both returned to their winning ways. Lewes won a difficult match at Maidstone United on the Monday evening, Tim Rivers scoring the only goal of a good even game just five minutes from the end. Then the following evening, Croydon Athletic maintained their five point lead with a 4-1 win at home to Whyteleafe – Dan Moody notching his first hat-trick of the season here.

In the other South East match, Eastbourne Town won 4-0 at Horsham, with two goals from Oliver Davies helping secure the points.

The final two Third Round ties in the Isthmian Youth Cup competition were successfully completed during the week, with a 4-1 home win for Tonbridge Angels against Margate, and a 2-0 success for Staines Town at holders Leatherhead. At the same time, Boreham Wood became the first team to reach the semi-finals, with a 2-0 victory at Carshalton Athletic. The runners-up from last season were forced to go to extra time before two goals from Smith clinched the game.
