MONTHLY AWARDS

LA SENZA WOMENS CUP

Enfield Town Ladies secured their first trophy of the season with an 8-0 victory in the La Senza Womens Cup final against Merstham on Wednesday evening. Merstham had no answer to the visitors who play a couple of divisions higher in the South East Womens Combination.

Enfield Town scored through a Holly Wilson hat-trick plus goals by Robyn Downie, Kerrie Marlborough, Shannon Moloney (pen), Jo Spinks and Beth Lovell. Enfield Town manager John Abbott said "It was a great team performance with everyone sticking to

their task and showing our hosts respect. I am a very proud manager and now just want to add more silverware to the cabinet."

The match was watched by a crowd of 110, and League Chairman Alan Turvey presented the trophies to the two teams and the match officials at the conclusion of the game.

ISTHMIAN VETERANS CUP

Two second half goals saw Northwood go down to a 2-0 defeat at the hands of Bromley in the final of the Isthmian Veterans' Cup at Chestnut Avenue on Monday evening.

Woods' "old-timers" did very well to get to the final in their second season in the competition, but goals from Jerry Dolke (51 minutes) and a Grant Watts penalty in the 73rd minute meant that Bromley retained the trophy they won last year.

WEEKEND REVIEW

The final round of matches saw the last of the championship, playoff of relegation positions decided and it was joy for Aveley, whose 3-2 victory at East Thurrock United gave them the Division One North championship. As for playoff positions Carshalton Athletic, at Hendon, and Sutton United, at home to AFC Hornchurch, celebrated 2-1 victories to put them in the Premier Division playoffs, in fourth and fifth place, respectively, with Hornchurch just missing out in sixth spot. In Division One North, the Rocks will join third-placed Brentwood Town, who drew 0-0 at home to

21st placed Witham Town, Waltham Abbey, 1–0 conquerors of Redbridge, and Concord Rangers, 1–0 winners at Maldon Town, in the playoffs. The Division One South picture was all-but settled going into the final day, but the finishing order saw Cray Wanderers hold onto second place after beating Eastbourne Town 3–0, and they finished ahead of Fleet Town, 2–1 victors at Dulwich Hamlet, Metropolitan Police, 1–0 conquerors of Merstham at Imber Court, and Worthing, 3–0 winners at Corinthian–Casuals.

So it is congratulations to Dover Athletic, champions of the Premier Division – with a superb 104 points after their 2–0 win at third-placed Tonbridge Angels – Aveley winners of Division One North, and Kingstonian – who drew 1–1 at Ashford Town – the Division One South title-claimers.

The Premier Division bottom four, from last place up, were Ramsgate, 3–0 losers at home to Ashford Town, Heybridge Swifts, who went down 2–0 at Canvey Island, Harlow Town, losers by the same score at home to Tooting & Mitcham United, and Margate, who were on the wrong end of a 4–1 defeat at the hands of runners-up Staines Town, who thus ended their run of nine games without a win. Division One North basement-dwellers Hillingdon Borough ended with a win, 1–0 at home Waltham Forest, but they were still 11 points behind Witham and 18 away from their victims, with Potters Bar Town – 1–0 losers at home to Chatham Town two points further away. In Division One South, Crowborough Athletic's miserable season ended with a 2–0 defeat at Whyteleafe and they finished 20 points behind Chipstead – 2–0 losers at Burgess Hill Town – and a further seven adrift of Corinthian–Casuals, Burgess Hill and Whyteleafe.

The other matches in the Premier Division saw no goals at Meadow Park, Boreham Wood, where Dartford were the visitors, Horsham beat Harrow Borough at Worthing with a single goal, Billericay Town succeed likewise at Maidstone United and Wealdstone also record a solitary-goal victory, at home to Hastings United.

In Division One North, Great Wakering and Enfield Town both scored three times, Rovers netting their goals – without reply – in a four-minute period to beat Cheshunt at Burroughs Park, while the Towners did concede one at Thamesmead Town. It certainly seemed that 1–0 wins were the order of the day because, in addition, to Hillingdon, Concord, Chatham and Waltham Abbey, Northwood – who missed out

on the playoffs by two points – won by the same score at Ilford, as did Ware at home to Wingate & Finchley. Leyton and Tilbury ended all-square at Lea Bridge Road, both teams scoring once.

In Division One South, Folkestone Invicta were the day's top scorers, winning 4–0 at home Walton Casuals, Leatherhead beat Sittingbourne 3–0 at Fetcham Grove, while both Walton & Hersham at Croydon Athletic and Godalming Town, at Whitstable Town, ended with 1–1 draws.

Premier Division

A dramatic afternoon at Longmead Stadium ended with Dover Athletic beating Tonbridge Angels 2–0, Lassana Sidibe, 17 minutes, and Jon Wallis, a 35th-minute penalty, scoring the goals. The first half was marred by a serious injury to the Whites' Lee Browning and a number of red cards being flourished by the appointed referee and his replacement. Staines Town ended their nine-match run without a win by consigning Margate to a bottom-four finish. Darti Brown converted a penalty after eight minutes and this was followed by a hat-trick from Richard Butler. He scored after 11, 33 and 54 minutes. Kenny Pratt netted a consolation in the final minute. Staines will now face Sutton United, who beat AFC Hornchurch 2–1 to leap-frog over them. Danny Phillips gave the Us the lead after 39 minutes, but Frankie Curley equalised three minutes into the second half. The winner came from the penalty spot, converted by Steve Watts 16 minutes from time.

Two goals in three minutes early in the second half at Wembley were enough for Carshalton Athletic to clinch fourth place with a 2–1 defeat of Hendon. Premier Division golden boot-winner Richard Jolly scored after 48 minutes, with Charlie Ide doubling the advantage two minutes later. James Burgess scored the Greens' consolation with almost the last touch. Two Leon Antoine goals, after 35 and 43 minutes, gave Canvey Island a 2–0 victory at home to Heybridge Swifts, while Dean McDonald, 10 minutes, and Paul Vines, 89, were the Tooting & Mitcham United marksmen as they won 2–0 at Harlow Town.

Darren Budd scored after 59 minutes for Horsham at home to Harrow Borough and it was enough for the Hornets to claim all three points. Rikki Burbridge was on target after 35 minutes for Billericay Town at Maidstone United as they also won 1–0. Ashford Town (Middlesex) finished the season as they started it, with a good victory, 3–0 at

Ramsgate, with goals from Billy Jeffries, 21 minutes, Scott Harris, 66, and Anthony Joseph, 73. And Boreham Wood ended their season with a goalless draw at home to Dartford.

Division One North

The match of the day was at Rookery Hill, where the title decider took place between hosts East Thurrock United and Aveley. It was the visitors who went home with the championship trophy after a pulsating and dramatic clash in front of 845 spectators. Petrit Elbi gave the visitors the lead after 35 minutes, but Steve Harrison equalised nine minutes into the second half. Martin Tuohy then put the Rocks in front after 62 minutes. East Thurrock then saw a Tuohy penalty saved by James Marrable before the Millers level with 16 minutes to go, Richard Ketchell heading home. With six minutes to go, Elbi scored his second of the afternoon to give Aveley the lead again. But, with second to go, Marrable was dismissed for a professional foul conceding a penalty into the bargain. Defender Glen Golby took over the gloves and produced a superb save not only to deny Max Cornhill but also to win the title for his team.

Marshall Smith scored Ware's goal after 12 minutes, and it was enough for them to beat Wingate & Finchley at Wodson Park. Eugene Ofori scored three minutes into the second half as Northwood scored a solitary-goal victory at Ilford. Harry Elmes left it until the final minute to break the deadlock at Capershots as Waltham Abbey beat Redbridge 1–0. Steve Hale ensured Hillingdon Borough's miserable season ended on a positive note with his 73rd minute goal the difference against Waltham Forest. A stunning strike by Fabian Batchelor after 75 minutes separated Concord Rangers and Maldon Town as the visitors claimed all three points. And the sixth 1–0 win of the day came at Potters Bar Town where Chatham Town's Brad Potter was the 86th-minute match-winner.

At Burroughs Park, Billy Johnson, Jack O'Connor and Michael Fox scored after 56, 67 and 69 minutes, respectively as Great Wakering Rovers beat Cheshunt 3–0. Luke Marshall, 28 minutes, and Anthony Jones, 39, gave Enfield Town a 2–0 lead at Thamesmead Town. Sam Thomas pulled a goal back just before half-time, but the Towners made sure of the points with Nick McCoy netting midway through the second half. Leyton took the lead at home to Tilbury with a goal from Phil Kane after 33 minutes. But Nicky Begg earned a point for the Dockers with an equaliser a

minute into the second half. And Brentwood Town set themselves up for the playoffs with a goalless home draw against Witham Town.

Division One South

Champions Kingstonian ended their campaign with a 1–1 draw against Ashford Town at the Homelands. Stanley Muguo gave the hosts the lead after 50 minutes, but Andy Thompson scored for the Ks with 16 minutes to go. Cray Wanderers got a pair of goals from Leigh Bremner, after 53 and 55 minutes, and completed their 3–0 home against Eastbourne Town with a Scott Kinch goal in the final five minutes. Ross Treleaven also scored twice, for Worthing at Corinthian–Casuals. He netted after 22 and 74 minutes, and Andy Alexander completed this 3–0 win in the 90th minute.

Steve Harper and Toby Phillips scored in the opening and closing minutes of the first half as Burgess Hill Town won 2–0 at Chipstead. And it was the same story for the other bottom-two club, basement-dwellers Crowborough Athletic, who succumbed to second-half strikes from Sean Rivers and Ellis Conroy. And there were four second-half goals at the Buzzlines Stadium, where hosts Folkestone Invicta inflicted a 4–0 defeat on Walton Casuals. Michael Everitt opened the scoring after 48 minutes, Jacob Arnold-Smith doubled the advantage five minutes later, and James Dryden added two more, after 61 and 71 minutes. A solitary goal, from Julian Edwards after 63 minutes, gave Metropolitan Police a 1–0 win at home to Merstham.

Nathan Smart's 84th-minute winner gave Fleet Town a home playoff match. Playing at Dulwich Hamlet, Paul Harkness gave Fleet the lead midway through the first half, but Dulwich levelled through Daniel Francis eight minutes after the resumption. Then came the match-winner. There was no such drama at Fetcham Grove, where hosts Leatherhead defeated Sittingbourne 3–0. Steve Barilli scored after eight minutes and the Tanners go further goals from Tom Hutchins, 22 minutes, and Kev Terry, 80. The other two matches ended in 1–1 draws. At the Keith Tuckey Stadium, Croydon Athletic took the lead through a Danny Waldren penalty after 11 minutes, only for Julien Thompson to restore parity nine minutes after oranges. And at Whitstable Town, the Oystermen took the lead through Ian Pulman after 51 minutes. Godalming Town snatched a point with Brahim Eloumani's equaliser 12 minutes later.

Ryman Youth League

There was a lot of activity in the Ryman Youth League this week, with new leaders appearing at the top of the South East Division. Two wins, and seventeen goals, took Lewes above previous leaders Croydon Athletic by one point, with Sam Schaff scoring a hat-trick in their first win of the week against Horsham YMCA.

At the same time, wins for Worthing – 4-0 at home to Horsham YMCA, and Tonbridge Angels – 6-0 at Horsham with a hat-trick from Matthew Knight, saw these two clubs draw level with Croydon Athletic at the crowded top of the table.

In the North East Division, second placed AFC Wimbledon won the top of the table clash at leaders Staines Town 3-1, and are now just five points behind the front runners with two games in hand – both to be played this week. And then the two meet in the last game of the season at the Kingsmeadow ground on the last evening of the Youth League season.

AFC Wimbledon also progressed to the Final of the Isthmian Youth Cup, winning 4-2 on penalties against Tonbridge Angels on Thursday evening, after the teams remained goalless at the end of extra time.
